Code of Conduct Policy

Purpose

Bicycle Wagga Wagga exists to unite cycling enthusiasts in a spirit of camaraderie, adventure, and healthy living. Our Code of Conduct provides a framework for behaviour that ensures every member feels safe, respected, and empowered to enjoy cycling, whether on the road, trail, or at club events.

Respect for All Members

- Members are expected to treat one another with kindness, courtesy, and consideration, embracing the diversity of our club.
- Disrespectful conduct—including bullying, harassment, discrimination, or exclusion—has no place in Bicycle Wagga Wagga.
- Support and encouragement should be offered to all club members, particularly newcomers and less experienced riders.

Commitment to Safety

- Comply with all relevant traffic laws, cycling regulations, and safety guidelines.
- Wear a helmet and use visibility aids, such as lights and reflective gear, as required.
- Regularly inspect and maintain your bicycle and equipment to ensure safety for yourself and fellow riders.
- Participate in club rides appropriate for your experience and fitness level, and respect the guidance of ride leaders.
- Promptly report accidents, hazards, or unsafe behaviour to club organisers.

Environmental Responsibility

- Show respect for the environment by cleaning up after yourself, properly disposing of waste, and protecting natural habitats during rides.
- Be mindful of wildlife and plant life, and avoid disturbing local ecosystems.



Representing Bicycle Wagga Wagga

- Act as a positive ambassador for Bicycle Wagga Wagga, both during club activities and in the wider community.
- Refrain from any behaviour that could harm Bicycle Wagga Wagga's reputation.
- Use club branding—such as the name or logo—only with official authorisation.

Conduct Online and in Social Media

- Engage online in a respectful and constructive manner, especially in club forums and social media spaces.
- Do not post offensive, misleading, or defamatory content associated with the club.
- Protect the privacy of members by refraining from sharing personal information without consent.

Resolving Disputes

- Approach disagreements with openness and respect, seeking amicable solutions wherever possible.
- If necessary, raise concerns with club organisers or the committee for impartial mediation.

Compliance and Consequences

Any violation of this Code of Conduct may result in appropriate disciplinary action, including warnings, suspension, or termination of club membership, as determined by the committee.

Acceptance

By joining Bicycle Wagga Wagga, members affirm their commitment to this Code of Conduct. The club reserves the right to amend this policy as needed to best serve its members and mission.
